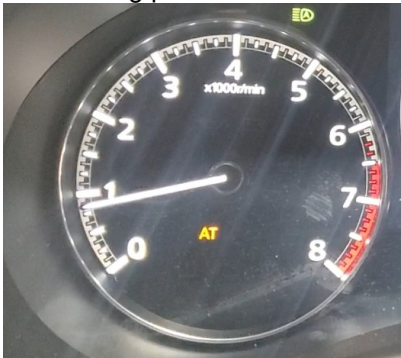

DESCRIPTION

The A/T (Automatic Transmission) warning light is flashing in the instrument cluster at new car delivery, without any DTCs being present.



Vehicles having this concern should be repaired using the following repair procedure prior to delivery to the customer.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

The TCM may still be in Factory Mode causing the A/T warning light to flash continuously. To take the TCM out of Factory Mode, turn the IG OFF -> IG ON -> IG OFF approximately 120 times at a steady pace to clear the warning light.

WARRANTY INFORMATION

- This warranty information applies only to verified customer complaints on vehicles eligible for warranty repair.
- This repair will be covered under Mazda’s New Vehicle Limited Warranty term.
