#### W161 Most Notable Improvements

**Important:** Improvements will vary by model, build configuration, system, and sales region. Not all vehicles have all features.

Most notable improvements contained in this release may include:

#### Radio:

- That the home screen bar may be missing on the left side of the display (only happens in guest profile).
- Presets may be lost over an ignition cycle.
- Home button may be inoperable.
- Multiple apps may be inoperable, such as MyGMC and CarPlay.
- Return to dealer message on Display Center Stack Module (CSM) may be present.

#### Phone:

- Phone settings may not retain over ignition cycle, unable to delete paired phones, etc.
- Call audio may be lost when a customer gets a second call while they are on the first call.

#### Cluster (IPC):

• Log in as guest message may be present on Integrated Center Stack (ICS) — Demo Mode
