Today, November 10, 2023, Acura is announcing a **product update** for certain 2022-2023 MDX vehicles to update the PGM-FI software that may affect the idle stop operation under certain conditions. **Perform an iN VIN status inquiry to determine which units in your inventory are affected.**

**BACKGROUND**

Under certain circumstances, after coming to a stop and the idle stop feature engages, the vehicle may not automatically restart. Typically, the client can immediately restart the vehicle by selecting Park and pushing the ENGINE START/STOP button.

**REPAIR**

Update the PGM-FI software.

**PARTS**

The software is available at launch.

**TOOLS**

There are no special tools needed for this campaign.

**SERVICE BULLETIN**

Service Bulletin 23-001, *Product Update: 2016-23 MDX PGM-FI Idle Stop Software Update* has posted to the Service Information System (SIS) as of November 10, 2023. It includes software, repair, and warranty information related to these campaigns.
