

| Cause | The cause of the condition may be that in high temperatures, the retention force is insufficient to retain the panel when opening the armrest. |

Service Procedure



1. Add 3M Scotch-Weld Structural Plastic Adhesive DP8010 adhesive (or equivalent) in the snap retention features at front of armrest lower panel shown above.

2. Reinstall the armrest lower panel at front edge per the illustration above and allow adhesive to dry per directions on packaging (10 minute work life with 60 minute handling strength).

3. Verify the condition is corrected.
