Symptom/Vehicle Issue: The customer may complain of a check engine light and the Air Conditioning (A/C) may be inoperative.


Diagnosis: When scanning the vehicle the technician may observe DTC's P0645 A/C Control Circuit Open and/or U0109 Lost Communication with Fuel Pump Control Module.


Discussion: Inspect the C1 connector at the PCM, connector D3821A, for bent or spread terminals. For DTC P0645 check on circuits C18 Pin 37 and C13 Pin 63. For DTC U0109 check on circuits K181 Pin 40, N7 Pin 41 and N9 Pin 65. Repair any circuits that are found to have bent or spread terminals according to published guidelines.


