**Symptom/Vehicle Issue:** Automatic Emergency Braking (AEB) and/or Forward Collision Warning (FCW) will shut off.

**Customer Complaint/Technician Observation:** While driving the customer may notice that the Automatic Emergency Braking (AEB) and/or Forward Collision Warning (FCW) will shut off. They will see two separate icons on the lower left and right sides of the Instrument Panel Cluster (IPC). This can be caused by sun blindness, rain, snow, foggy conditions or other conditions that inhibit the camera to see clearly.



**Discussion**: At this time do not replace any parts or perform any calibrations for this concern. It is recommended to reassure the customer that this is normal behavior of the system to warn the driver of the temporary unavailability of the system. A software flash for the Forward Facing Camera (HALF Module) and the Instrument Panel Cluster (IPC) is expected to be released in Quarter 1 of 2024.
