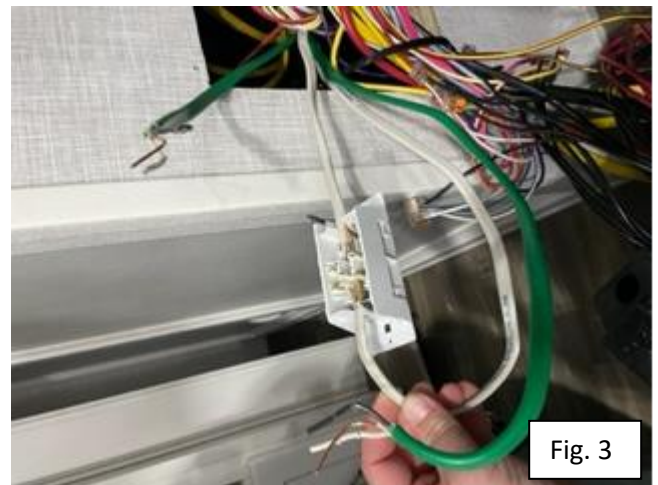

INVERTER WIRING REPAIR INSTRUCTIONS

1. Ensure main breaker at converter is flipped in the “off” position and the unit is unplugged from shore power.
2. Go inside coach and remove converter by removing the cover and then all 4 screws securing the converter with a #2 square bit.
3. Find the blank receptacle containing two 14-2 green wires and two 14-2 white wires. Remove the green wires from the blank receptacle. **Figures 1 and 2**



Feed a new green 14-2 wire and a new white 14-2 wire back into the basement where the inverter is desired to be installed (recommended to go under the basement floor in the pass through storage). (Figures 3-5)



4. Install the new white wire in the existing blank recept and resecure. (Figure 6)



5. Install the new green wire in a new blank recept with the two green wires that were removed in step 3. **Figure 7**
6. The green wire in the pass through is the “out” for the inverter and the white wire is the “in” on the inverter. Reinstall the converter.
