Symptom/Vehicle Issue: Power Side Step Does Not Operate Or Operates

Intermittently

Customer Complaint/Technician Observation: Power Side Step Module (PSSM) may work intermittently. May not deploy or retract at times. Customer may mention a related symptom of air suspension (if equipped) may not work intermittently.

Discussion:

- 1. Using wiTECH, check Diagnostic Trouble Codes (DTC's) and follow DTC guidelines from library to troubleshoot in detail.
- 2. Double check wiring/terminal/connection conditions. Note: Also inspect connections at the motor, PSSM controller, and Inline wiring/connectors/terminals. Inspect for the following:
- Proper connector installation.
- Damaged connector locks.
- Corrosion.
- Other signs of water intrusion.
- Weather seal damage (if equipped).
- Bent terminals.

- Overheating due to a poor connection (terminal may be discolored due to excessive current draw).
- Terminals that have been pushed back into the connector cavity.
- Check for spread terminals and verify proper terminal tension.
- 3.If no issue found replace the motor first cycle the doors to see if the issue is solved.
- 4. If motor replacement does not resolve the issue, disconnect and reconnect PSSM controller, cycle the doors to see if the issue persist.
- 5. If issue persist replace PSSM controller.
- 6. New PSSM will require a proxi and configuration procedure to enable PSSM. Note: For WS driving the vehicle above 16Km/hr (10mph) is required to enable PSSM controller.
