DESCRIPTION


Some customers may experience an issue where thehood cannot be opened using the release cable. To open the hood for diagnosis and repairs, follow the repair procedure below.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

The procedure in MGSS directs you to remove the front bumper for hood cable and latch repairs, however, you need the hood open to do that. To open the hood, you do not need to to remove the bumper, and the final repair may be as simple as properly attaching the cable to the latch. (See the photos below.)

NON-DESTRUCTIVE WAY TO GET TO THE LATCH AND OPEN THE HOOD

- 1. Pull the inner fender panel.
- 2. Reach up to access the hole in the core support.
- 3. Manually operate the lever to open the latch.
- 4. Repair the vehicle as needed.
