DIAGNOSIS:

If a customer's VIN is listed in VIP or your RSU VIN list, perform the Repair Procedure. If any vehicle not on the VIN list exhibits the symptom listed above in the customer symptom section, perform the Repair Procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE:

NOTE: The pedals can be adjusted with the ignition in the OFF position.




Fig. 1 Adjustable Brake And Accelerator Pedals Button

1. Verify if the adjustable brake pedal is functioning by pressing the activation button (Fig. 1).

- 2. Did the brake pedal adjust?
- YES>>> This bulletin has been completed, use the Inspection LOP (05-50-02-93) to close the active RSU.
- NO>>> Proceed to Step 3.
- Replace the brake and accelerator pedal assembly. Refer to the detailed service procedures available in DealerCONNECT/Service Library under: Service Info>05 - Brakes / Hydraulic/Mechanical / Pedal(s), Brake and/or Accelerator / Removal and Installation.
- 4. Using a Scan Tool (wiTECH), perform a "Learn ETC" routine. This routine can be found in PCM Misc Functions.
- 5. Perform a "ABS Initialization" routine. This routine can be found in BSCM Misc Functions then ABS Initialization.
