Information	 The 6L50 (MYB), 6L80 (MYC) and 6L90 (MYD) Transmission Oil Filter and Seal Kit part number 24236933 is currently transitioning from a kit to the filter and seal being sold individually. This is being done to improve packaging efficiencies: Filter Part Number 24236517 and Seal Part Number 24225347 will need to be ordered separately to obtain both pieces. 			
	 Current service procedures require that seal be replaced anytime the filter is removed. The Electronic Parts Catalog (EPC) is being updated to reflect these changes.
