

**Symptom/Vehicle Issue:** Day Night Mode Illumination on the Instrument Panel Cluster (IPC)

and/or Radio Switches Frequently Under Low Lighting Conditions

Customer Complaint/Technician Observation: The customer may complain after a recent service repair which included recall 88A that their instrument panel and/or radio backlighting has become more sensitive to light changes and may switch between night and day mode while driving.

**Discussion**: For vehicles which experience a day night mode light sensitivity condition, see the updated recall instructions for 88A and perform the wiTECH "Restore Vehicle Configuration" routine from the Guided Diagnostics tab and confirm the operation. The updates will sync any previous service configurations to resolve the concern. Do not replace any parts for this concern, parts are not required to resolve this condition.
