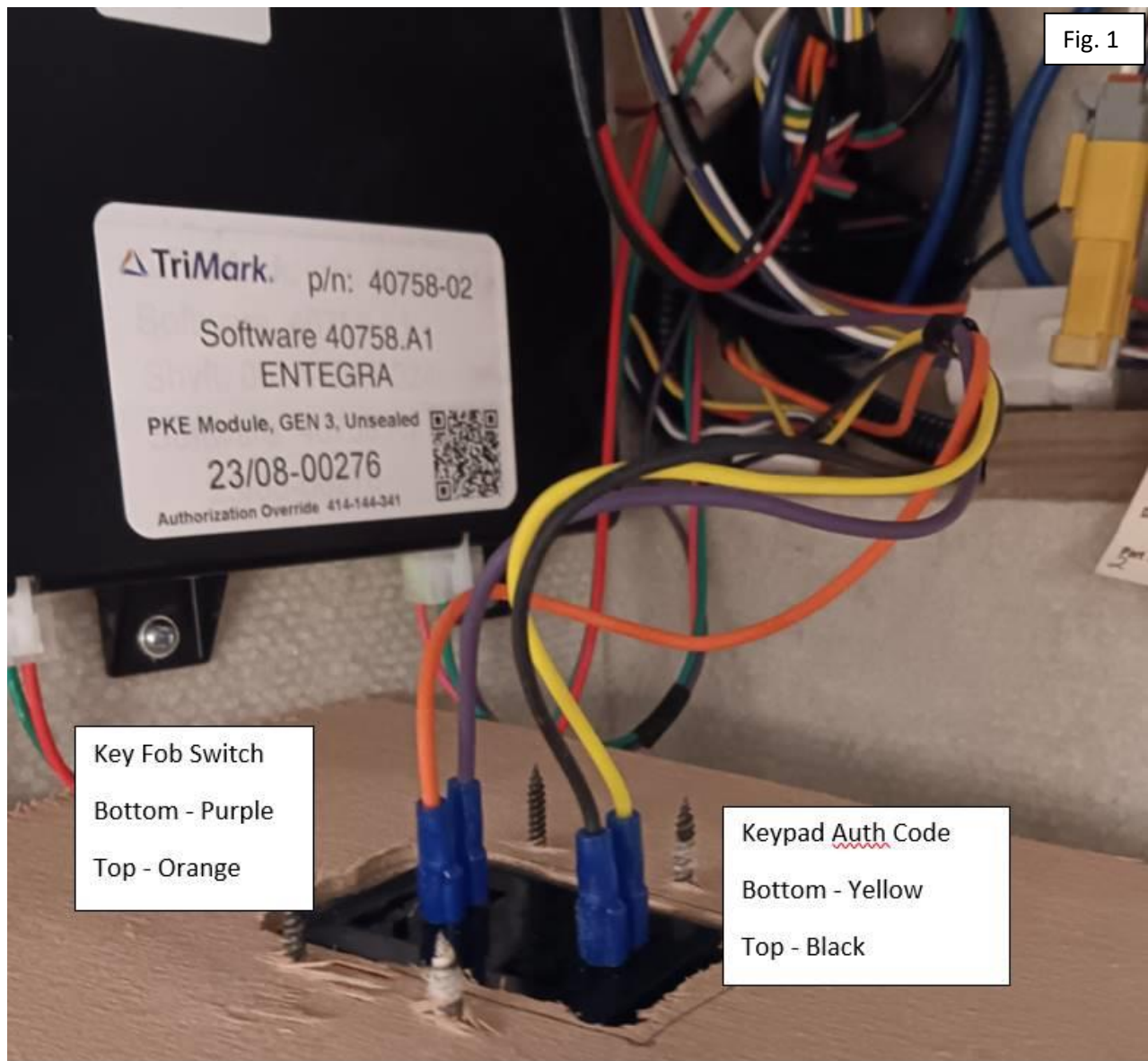

KEYLESS PROGRAMMING SWITCH WIRING REPAIR INSTRUCTIONS

1. Inspect the back of the keyless entry programming switches labeled “Key Fob” and “Keypad Auth. Code”. Switches are located inside the driver’s front overhead cabinet.
2. Remove screws holding panel that switches are mounted to.
3. Tilt panel down enough to inspect back of the switches.
4. Inspect wires to the switches, the wires should match Figure 1.
 - a. If wires DO NOT match move to step 5.
 - b. No further action is required if wires DO match.
5. Remove wires from switches. When removing wires pull from the blue slide connectors in the picture. DO NOT pull on wires themselves.
6. Attach wires to the switches following the label in the below picture.
7. Replace panel in place and secure with screws.



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
