Condition

Customer states:

- The touch-operated volume control in the center console is not working.
- The volume control, as well as the skip buttons are inoperable.

Workshop findings:

The following DTC or DTCs and symptom code(s) may be stored in *Information Electronics name* -J794-, (address word 005F):

• DTC U11B900: Volume control no communication (active/static).

Service

Perform a terminal 30 reset for volume regulator E67:

Remove the relevant fuse for at least 10 seconds and then, replace it.

After the terminal 30 reset, check whether the volume control is working.

If it is working, no further repairs are required.

If the volume control is not working after the terminal 30 reset, replace volume regulator E67.
