Rear Bumper Cover To Quarter Panel Poor Fitment And/Or Excessive Body Gap - Built On Or Before 04-Dec-2023

This bulletin supersedes 23-2302. Reason for update: New Part/Procedure For Same Condition

Summary

This article supersedes TSB 23-2302 to update the Service Procedure and Parts List.

Issue: Some 2024 Mustang vehicles built on or before 04-Dec-2023 may exhibit a condition where the rear bumper cover has poor fitment and/or excessive body gap where it meets the quarter panel. This may be due to incorrect installation and/or poor attachment to the bumper support bracket. To correct this condition, follow the Service Procedure to replace the rear bumper cover side bracket with revised versions.

Action: Follow the Service Procedure to correct the condition that meets the following criteria:

- 2024 Mustang
- Built on or before 04-Dec-2023
- Rear bumper cover has poor fitment and/or excessive body gap where it meets the quarter panel

Quantity refers to the amount of the service part number required to repair the vehicle.

Unit of Issue refers to the number of individual pieces included in a service part number package.

Piece Quantity refers to the total number of individual pieces required to repair the vehicle.

If Needed indicates the part is not mandatory.

Warranty Status: Eligible under provisions of New Vehicle Limited Warranty (NVLW)/Service Part Warranty (SPW)/Special Service Part (SSP)/Extended Service Plan (ESP) coverage. Limits/policies/prior approvals are not altered by a TSB. NVLW/SPW/SSP/ESP coverage limits are determined by the identified causal part and verified using the OASIS part coverage tool.


- 1. Does the rear bumper cover have poor fitment and/or excessive body gap where it meets the quarter panel as shown in Figure 1?
 - (1). Yes proceed to Step 2.
 - (2). No this article does not apply.



- 2. Remove the rear bumper cover. Refer to Workshop Manual (WSM), Section 501-19.
- 3. Replace the right hand side and left hand side rear bumper cover side brackets shown in Figure 2. Figure 2 (Left Side Shown, Right Side Similar)



NOTE: Be sure that the foam block is located in the area shown in Figure 3 on the left and right side of the vehicle when the rear bumper cover is installed. If the foam block is loose or is missing install a new foam block.
