Technical Background

A hardware issue in the Audi virtual cockpit may cause it to have a white sheen. All the display content is still visible and functional through the white sheen.

Production Solution

Optimized instrument cluster hardware in production as of 01/01/2022.

Service

- 1. In your warranty claim notes document the production date of the instrument cluster. To do so:
 - a. Using ODIS: Right click diagnostic address 17>>Identification>>Production date
- 2. Replace the Audi Virtual Cockpit -J285- according to the instructions of the ELSA repair manual.



NOTICE

If the replacement cluster is produced BEFORE the 01/01/2022, it is still ok to use as a replacement.
