


Figure 1. Rear side windows (rear door and/or rear side windows) appear cloudy/milky.

Depending on the position of the sun and the perspective, the rear door and/or rear side windows are cloudy/milky in appearance (Figure 1).

Despite this appearance, the rear door and/or rear side windows are fully compliant with the series approval status and not defective.
