

Additional Options (RPOs)			
Condition	Some customers may comment on a clunking or clicking noise from the second-row seats without a passenger.		
Cause	The cause of the condition may be due to incorrect torque of the seat retaining bolts.		
Correction	Confirm the condition and that the cause is not due to the seat not being properly latched. Then, perform a retorque of second row seat bolts as described in the Service Procedure.		

#### **Service Procedure**

#### **Captains Chairs**

- Refer to document Rear Seat Removal and Installation in the Service Manual for instruction on how to reuse fasteners or install new ones.
- 2. Remove the front fasteners.
- 3. Loosen but DO NOT remove fasteners (1) and (2).
- Leave fastener (2) loose and retighten inboard fastener (1), refer to the document on how to reuse fasteners.
- 5. Remove fastener (2).





- 6. Reinstall all remaining bolts referring to the pattern shown.
- 7. Refer to the document for instruction on how to reassemble trim

#### **Bench Seats**

- Refer to document Rear Seat Removal and Installation in the Service Manual for instruction on how to reuse fasteners or install new ones.
- 2. Remove the front fasteners.
- 3. Loosen but DO NOT remove fasteners (1), (2), and (3).
- 4. Leave fastener (3) loose and retighten inboard fastener (1) and (2), refer to the document on how to reuse fasteners.
- 5. Remove fastener (3).
