SITUATION



The bar code on the vehicle identification number (VIN) label <u>(aka</u> <u>Manufacturer Compliance Label)</u> cannot be read.

Vehicle's with <u>such an incorrect label do not</u> meet federal regulations.

CORRECTION

Remove and replace the VIN label on driver's B-pillar.

Note: DO NOT place the new label on top of the old label!

PROCEDURE

- 1. Using a heat gun, evenly apply heat to the entire label.
- 2. Using a plastic scraper or "fishbone" tool, peel off the original label.
- 3. Using isopropyl alcohol, remove the adhesive residue from the B-pillar.
- 4. Compare the VIN on the new label with the vehicle's VIN.
- 5. Smoothly apply the new label using the same orientation as the original label.
- 6. Smoothly press down over the entire label ensuring that there are no trapped bubbles under the label.
