# Replacement Requirement for Center Console Support: Observing Special Procedure when Replacing Component (216/23)

Model Line: Cayenne (9YA)

Model Year: 2019

Concerns: Center console support

Cause: The center console support with index B installed in model year 2019 (K) is no longer available.

If a new center console support (index D or higher) is required for vehicles from these model years, the cover for the tray (center armrest) must also be replaced. The screw connection for the cover for the tray

(center armrest) has been changed from 2 to 4 screw points in the new component status.

If the center console support is required for a replacement, check the number of screw connections on

Action: the cover for the tray (center armrest) and

replace center console support if there are 4 screw points

or

 if there are 2 screw points replace the center console support and the cover for the tray (center armrest)

#### Information

The cover for the tray (center armrest) provided in the Porsche spare part catalogue (PET2) based on the vehicle ID no. corresponds to the previous component status and is **not** compatible with the new center console support.

The work procedure for determining the appropriate part number is described using an example in the section "Replacing center console carrier and, if necessary, cover for the tray (center armrest)".

#### Required tools

Tools:

- P90999 PIWIS Tester 4
- Battery charger with a current rating of at least 90 A, e.g., VAs 5908 battery charger 90 A. For further information about the battery chargers to be used, see the corresponding Workshop Manual. ⇒ Workshop Manual '270689 Charging vehicle electrical system and battery'
- Torque wrench, 2-10 Nm (1.5-7.5 ftlb.), e.g., V.A.G 1783 torque wrench, 2-10 Nm (1.5-7.5 ftlb.)
- Torque wrench, 20-100 Nm (15-74 ftlb.), e.g., VAS 5820 torque wrench, 20-100 Nm (15-74 ftlb.)
- Torque wrench, 40-200 Nm (30-148 ftlb.), e.g., V.A.G 1332A torque wrench, 40-200 Nm (30-148 ftlb.)

#### Replacing center console support and, if necessary, cover for the tray (center armrest)

Work Procedure: 1 Open cover for the tray (center armrest).

- Unclip cover ⇒ Cover -1 using a suitable tool ⇒ Cover-Arrows-.
- Check the number of screw connections on the cover for the tray (center armrest).

#### Information

The work procedure is described using a sample vehicle; the part numbers shown may differ if necessary.

- 4.1 In the Porsche spare part catalogue (PET2), identify and call up the vehicle with the vehicle ID no.
- 4.2 Then find the cover for the tray (center armrest) provided in the Porsche spare part catalogue (PET2) (Figure 809 040).

4.3 Determine and order the compatible cover for the tray (center armrest) using the graphic.




#### Information

The cover for the tray (center armrest) compatible with the new center console support is listed directly under the cover for the tray (center armrest) provided for the vehicle. This is greyed out, but is still to be used.

The part number highlighted in **red** in the graphic is the cover for the tray (center armrest) provided for the vehicle in the Porsche spare parts catalogue (PET2) but **not** compatible with the **new** center console support.

The part number highlighted in **green** in the graphic **or** its interpretations are compatible with the **new** center console carrier.

**green** – Required and compatible cover for the tray (center armrest)
