SHOWER SURROUND CORNER REPAIR INSTRUCTIONS

To access the screw in the white plastic anchor block at the bottom rail. First remove the screw at the top corner of the shower surround.



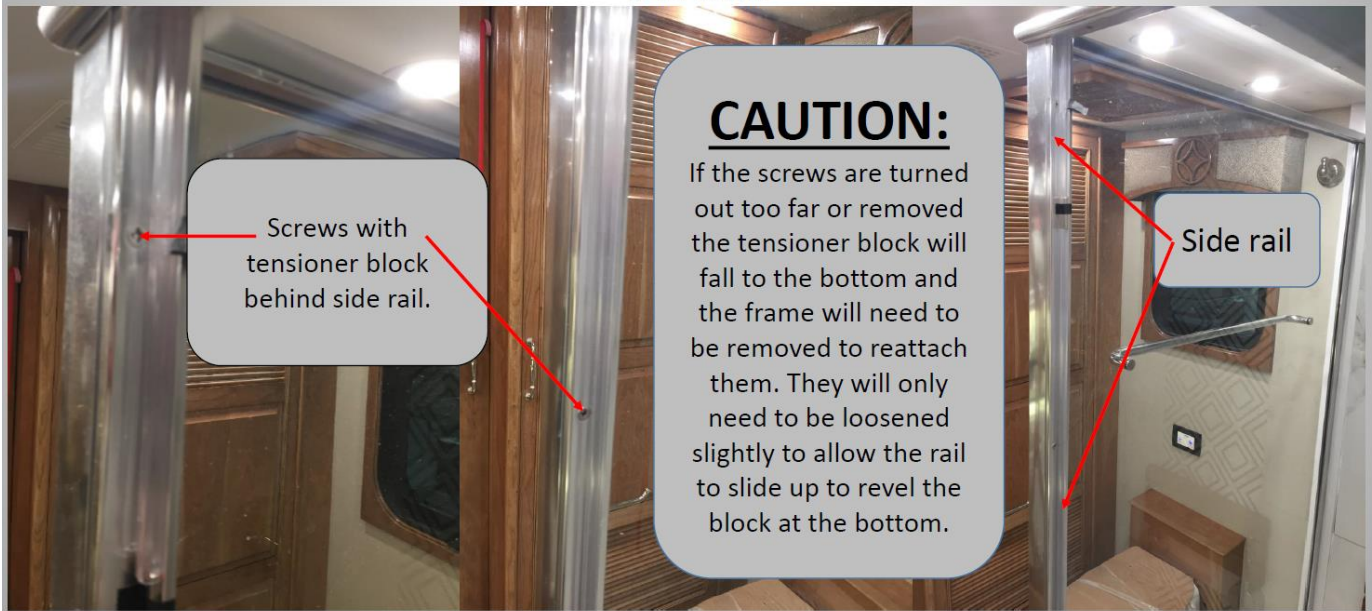
This will allow the top frame rail to lift and the vertical side rail to raise exposing the plastic anchor block and screw at the bottom of the frame.



Top frame rail.
Vertical side rail.

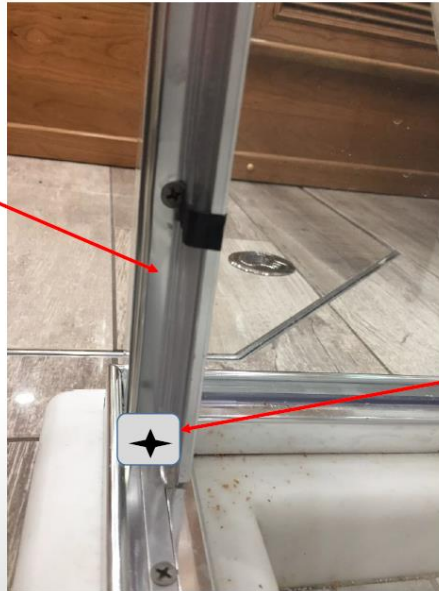


Only loosen the screws in the vertical side rail $\frac{1}{4}$ turn to loosen the rail.



When the side rail is raised the white plastic securing block will be visible at the bottom of the surround frame.

Slide the side rail up to access the plastic securing block and screw.



The plastic securing block and screw will be visible when the side rail is raised.

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
