## 90 "Maneuver assist: fault" message is displayed on the instrument cluster

## Condition

### Customer states:

- The message "Maneuver assist: fault. Please contact service" is briefly displayed on the instrument cluster after the vehicle is started.
- The message disappears after a few seconds.
- After the message disappears, the maneuver assist system functions normally.

### Workshop findings:

- The concern is sporadic.
- No relevant DTCs are stored in the driver assist systems control module, -J1121- (address word 00A5).

## Technical Background

After the drive system is activated quickly and a gear is selected immediately, the message "maneuver assist: fault. Please contact service" is briefly displayed in the instrument cluster as not all relevant network control units have yet been initialized.

## Production Solution

Not applicable.

## Service

This TSB replaces PSS 2064985: *PSS 91 "Maneuver assist: fault" message is displayed on the instrument cluster.*

No repair is available.

1. Do not perform any repairs. Any repairs for this concern may be denied.
2. Instruct the customer that this condition is normal.

## Workaround:

The maneuver assist can be deactivated manually to prevent further fault messages being displayed in the instrument cluster.

To do so, select the following on the home screen: **CAR > Parking aid > Maneuver assist.**

Or

When the parking aid is active, select  **Maneuver assist.**
