### **Service**

 Remove any adhesive residues from the front camera, as adhesive may have been used for securing it in the holder.



Tip: Protect the front camera against damage when removing the adhesive residues.

### Depending on the windshield proceed as follows:


A6 windshield with part number 4K0 845 099 A / B / F / G / H / J or A7 windshield with part number 4K8 845 099 B / K / L / F:



2. An aluminum foil (part number 4K0 907 231 MTR) has to be attached to the windshield to correct the pitch angle of the front camera. Manufacture a 5mmx10mm decal and stick it on the mounting bar of the front camera previously cleaned with Isopropanol (Figure 2 and 3).

2. If this windshield is installed, a correction of the pitch angle of the front camera with aluminum foil is not necessary. An optimized mount for the front camera on the windshield is already installed. If there is aluminum foil on the front camera, it must be removed.
