

Cause	These concerns could be caused by a broken or loose engine ground cable/strap,
Cause	which grounds the engine (2) to the body (1), as shown below.

Shown above is ground G132 loose.

Correction:

Inspect the engine to body ground cable/strap, G132 and G134. Tighten any loose ground connections or replace any damaged ground cable/strap. Ensure that the ground cable/strap is properly orientated to prevent damage to the ground cable/strap caused by powertrain movement.
