CAUSE:	Failed front or Rear Axle Locker Sensor.

DISCUSSION:

A service kit (Sensor Kit, Axle: 68544629AA) is available to repair the Axle Locker Sensor on the vehicles equipped with both the M210 and M220 Tru-Lok axles (Sales Code DSE). This parts kit must be used when the Axle Locker Sensor fails. Do not replace the Front or Rear Axle assemblies.
