



#### **Service Procedure**

- 1. Remove the tappet, turn clockwise ¼ turn and discard.
- 2. Align the new tappet base tabs to the hinge opening and turn counterclockwise ¼ turn, making sure the tappet boot is correctly positioned and

**Note:** The new tappet should NOT have any movement in any direction.
