| Condition                  | Some customers may comment on the LED light above the front floor console bin that illuminates the console bin or wireless charging pad (if equipped) is not illuminating at night. |  |  |
| Cause                      | The cause of the condition may be the X88 LED side of the connector was wired in reverse and causes the LED not to illuminate.  |  |  |
| Correction                 | To correct the issue, locate the X88 LED connector. On the LED side of the connector swap pins one and two with each other and re-test lamp operation.                              |  |  |
