Correction:

After a camera replacement the programming is done in 3 steps. First the SPS Calibrations are loaded. Then the SPS Set Up And Configuration is loaded and then the Camera Learn/ Configuration is performed through GDS2. Skipping any of these steps or performing them out of order can cause the above concerns.
