

# TECHNICAL SERVICE BULLETIN Convertible Top Requires Extra Effort To Latch

#### Model:

Ford 2022-2023 Mustang

**Issue:** Some 2022-2023 Mustang convertible vehicles may exhibit a convertible top that requires extra effort to latch. This may be due to the convertible top assembly that is out of specification. To correct the condition, follow the Service Procedure replace the convertible top assembly.

Action: Follow the Service Procedure to correct the condition on vehicles that meet all of the following criteria:

- 2022-2023 Mustang Convertible
- Has a convertible top that requires extra effort to latch

Claim Quantity refers to the total number of individual pieces required to repair the vehicle.

Package Order Quantity refers to the amount of the service part number package(s) required to repair the vehicle.

Number In Package refers to the number of individual pieces included in a service part number package.

**Warranty Status:** Eligible under provisions of New Vehicle Limited Warranty (NVLW)/Service Part Warranty (SPW)/Special Service Part (SSP)/Extended Service Plan (ESP) coverage. Limits/policies/prior approvals are not altered by a TSB. NVLW/SPW/SSP/ESP coverage limits are determined by the identified causal part and verified using the OASIS part coverage tool.

# **Service Procedure**

**1.** Replace the convertible top assembly. Refer to <u>WSM</u>, Section 501-18 Convertible Top > Removal and Installation > Convertible Top Assembly.

NOTE: New convertible top materials are intended to be tight when first installed. Advise the customer that the convertible should remain closed and latched for a minimum of 3 weeks to optimize latching efforts. Opening the top during this time may extend this break-in period.
