Customer states:

- The sunglass holder in the dome light assembly will not latch closed or is stuck closed.
- The condition may be intermittent.

Technical Background

The sunglass holder spring latch mechanism has been damaged due to the use of excessive force (e.g. storing glasses that are too large for the compartment) and no longer engages. The locking spring can be replaced separately. There is no need to replace the entire roof module.
