
SUBJECT: Lower Center Panel – Design Change

INTRODUCTION:

This bulletin announces the design change made to the lower right center panel. The change was incorporated to address cases of excessive passenger side gap between the shift lever cover and the console box. The new console panel has been reshaped to provide added rigidity and allow the shift cover to sit more evenly. If this gap is reported, replace the lower right center panel with the new part.
