Documentation needed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Photos of front wheelhouse cover plates <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Q7: 4M0803597G, 4M0803598G, 4M0803598H ○ Q8: 4M8803597B, 4M8803598B • With the rear portion of the front wheelhouse protectors either removed or loosened enough to gain visual access to the cover plates, photos are needed of the cover plates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ At a distance showing location ○ Close-up photos showing the condition of the plates in their entirety ○ Documentation of any damage to the coating as well as any corrosion on the cover plates. • The cover plates do not need to be removed from the vehicle. No other action is necessary. Wheelhouse protectors can be reinstalled after documentation is completed. • TAC case submitted with Worksheet “Corrosion on wheelhouse cover plate”.
