Information

Starting with model year 2025, the following components are not considered “standard” equipment and will not be included in the PDI dealer pack that comes from the factory.

MY 2025 Hummer EV Pickup & Hummer EV Pickup/SUV

- Portable Dual Level Charger Assembly with Swapable Plugs (RPO PSC). Note: If the customer orders RPO PSC when building the vehicle, this content will be included in the PDI dealer pack.
- Tool Kit for removing the front I-Bar. This includes the ratchet, short extension and 8mm hex socket.
- Trailer Tire Pressure Sensor Monitors (Qty 4)
- Underbody Aero Panels (Qty 2)
- Micro-fiber cleaning cloth

MY 2025 Silverado EV (WT and RST) & Denali EV

- Portable Dual Level Charger Assembly with interchangeable 120/240V plugs (RPO PSC). Note: If the customer orders RPO PSC when building the vehicle, this content will be included in the PDI dealer pack
