WRB3 - Updating On-Board Owner's Manual (Workshop Campaign)

Important: CRITICAL WARNING -This campaign includes steps where control unit(s) in the vehicle will be

programmed with the PIWIS Tester. The vehicle voltage must be maintained between 13.5 volts and 14.5 volts during this programming. Failure to maintain this voltage could result in damaged control unit(s). Damage caused by inadequate voltage during programming is not a warrantable defect. The technician must verify the actual vehicle voltage in the PIWIS Tester before starting the campaign and also document

the actual voltage on the repair order.

Model Year: As of 2022 up to 2024

Vehicle Type: 911 GT3 (992) / 911 GT3 with Touring Package (992) / 911 GT3 RS (992) / 911 S/T (992)

Concerns: On-board Owner's Manual

Cause: The engine oil of the C40 specification used today for the affected vehicles is being transferred

to the new Porsche C40 GT specification.

As a result, the engine oil specification in the on-board Owner's Manual in the customer vehicle no longer

corresponds to the current status.

Action: Update the on-board Owner's Manual using a USB stick and PIWIS Tester.

Please note that this is a supplementary action to the WRA2 workshop campaign.
