## Condition

### Customer statement:

Customer states the 3rd brake light does not work.

### Workshop findings:

The following DTC may be stored in Comfort System Central Control Module -J393-, (address word 0046)

- **DTC B12C615:** Bulb for high-mount brake light Open circuit/short circuit to B+ (Active/Passive)

## Technical Background

The printed circuit along the top of the rear glass may be damaged due to corrosion leading to the malfunction.

## Production Solution

Printed circuit on glass has been insulated in production.

Remove the seat belt feeder trim, C-pillar trim and rear shelf as indicated by position 1,2 and 3 in Figure 1.

Remove the 3rd brake light  
and unplug the lamp.



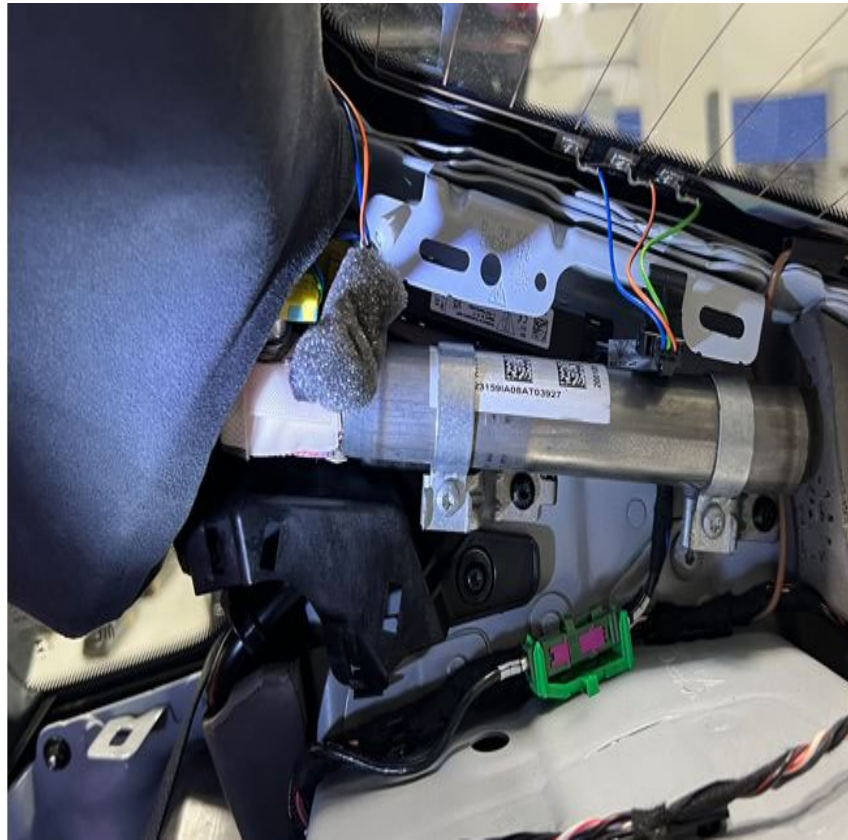
*Figure 2: Remove 3<sup>d</sup> brake light.*

Pull the foam insulated connector for the 3<sup>rd</sup> brake light circuit from behind the C-pillar.

Separate the connection and insert **4J3 971 157** into the vehicle side of the wire harness only.

In this step the wires leading to the welded points on the glass will remain unused.

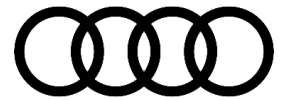

Wrap the unused connector end from the glass to the new harness.

Insulate as needed to prevent noise and future chaffing.

Loosely route the replacement harness **4J3 971 157** along the space between the headliner and glass.

Wrap the old connector end for the 3<sup>rd</sup> brake lamp to the new harness approx.. 90mm behind the new harness connector.



**Ensure enough length of the new harness is available to facilitate installation/removal of the 3<sup>rd</sup> brake lamp.**

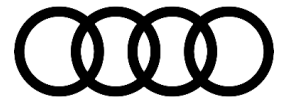


*Figure 6: Insulate connector and harness.*

Remove the label on the new harness to reduce risk of noise.

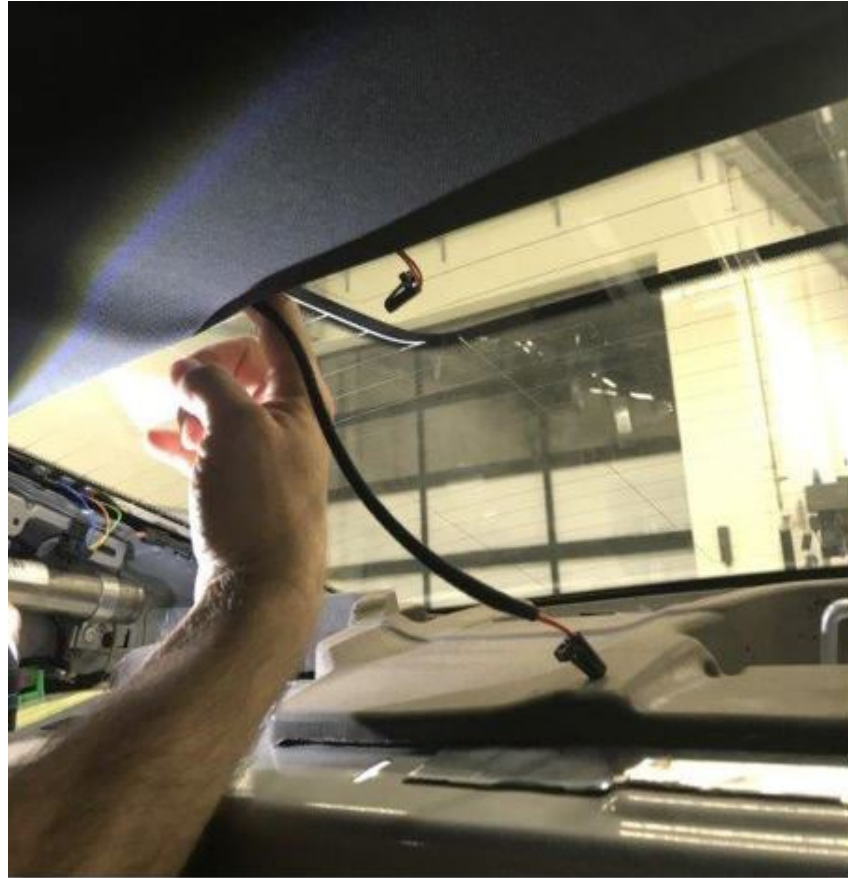

Insert the new harness **4J3 971 157** into the space between headliner and metal flange of the body.

Connect the new harness to the 3<sup>rd</sup> brake lamp.

Position/secure harness as needed to prevent noise and protrusion from behind the headliner.

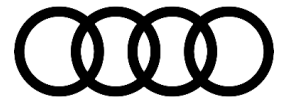
Re-assemble the vehicle in reverse sequence according to Workshop Manual.

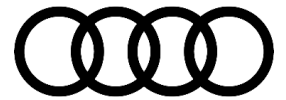
