‘What’s new?’ customer release summary	<p>This update enables improvements to SOTA (Software Over The Air) capability.</p> <p>Jaguar I-PACE only: Following this update, over the air updates will be possible whilst the vehicle is actively charging using an 'AC' charger, such as a home charger.</p> <p>Please note: If the vehicle is plugged in but not currently charging, you will need to schedule the update for the same time the vehicle is scheduled to be charging or disconnect the charging cable. Over the air updates can not be carried out whilst using rapid 'DC' chargers</p> <p>PHEV only: Please note that for a short period of time, you may experience some disruption in the EV capabilities after the update has completed. Please disconnect the vehicle charger and ensure the battery has a minimum charge level of 25% before starting the update.</p>
