PIT6022A Procedure To Release The Park Brakes When Battery Is Discharged

Involved Region or Country:	North America
Condition:	Need to manually release the parking brakes due to discharged battery.
Cause:	Follow procedure below.

With no power source the park brake will need to be manually retracted in one of two ways.

Preferred Method:

- 1.) Remove the (2) 5 mm Allen head screws mounting actuator to caliper.
- 2.) With same 5 mm Allen tool, turn spindle clockwise to draw the spindle-nut into the bore (stop after feeling resistance, do not use power tools)

The further the spindle-nut is drawn back, the further piston can be pushed back into the housing.

Alternative Method:

- 1.) Remove the (2) 14 mm guide rod bolts from caliper.
- 2.) Remove housing from caliper assembly.
- 3.) Using a brake piston tool, rotate piston (clockwise) in the bore to turn spindle-nut toward back of housing.

The further the spindle-nut is drawn back, the further piston can be pushed back into the housing.
