



## **SSM 52775 2024 Bronco - No Crank/No Start/Discharged Battery/Parasitic Battery Drain - Built On And Before 23-Jun-2024**

Some 2024 Bronco vehicles built on and before 23-Jun-2024 may exhibit a no crank/no start, discharged battery due to a parasitic battery drain condition. This may be due to the body control module C (BCMC). Perform battery drain test, refer to Workshop Manual (WSM) Section 414-01 Battery, Mounting and Cables - General Procedures - Battery Drain Check. If a battery drain of more than 1 Amp is identified, inspect fuse 8 in the BCMC for available voltage with the vehicle off and resting. If voltage is found, verify the draw is eliminated by removing fuse 8. If removing the fuse eliminates the draw, replace the BCMC, refer to WSM, Section 419-10. If removing the fuse does not eliminate the draw, refer to WSM for normal diagnostics. For claiming, use causal part 14A068 and applicable labor operations in Section 10 of the Service Labor Time Standards (SLTS) Manual.
