Symptom/Vehicle Issue: 2nd Row Seat Is Hard To Put Back In Position After Moving It Forward To Access The 3rd row seat.

Discussion: Duplicate the condition. If the 2nd row seat seems to bind or needs extra effort to place back into position the seat may need lubrication. See the below for further details.

Parts Required: MOPAR Multi-Purpose Grease 05083160AA or equivalent.

1. Tip forward the second-row seat.
2. Locate the seat rollers (Fig 1)
3. Add grease on both rollers of each seat (Fig 2).
4. Move the seat forward and backward multiple times and test operation.
