

WINDSHIELD WIPER PARK OPERATION

Customer Voice:

- A customer may report that the windshield wipers stop up on the windshield when turned off.

Technical Description:

- This may be caused by the 'Winter Park' mode being turned on through the settings menu on the touch screen.

Status:

- Should a customer express a concern, please first confirm the park setting selection in the settings menu.
- Windshield wiper operation is covered in the Owner Handbook as well as in section 501-16: Wipers and Washers – Description and Operation in the Workshop Manual on TOPIx.

WINTER PARK POSITION [93334075]

CAUTION:

Make sure the relevant cautions have been read and fully understood before using the wipers. See [WIPER CARE POINTS](#).

The wipers can be set to park in a higher position than normal, when the vehicle is parked. The higher park position aids the removal of snow, mud, leaves, etc.

The wipers move to the winter park position when the vehicle's ignition is switched off. The wipers remain in the winter park position until one of the following occurs:

1. The vehicle's speed is above 5 mph (8 km/h).
2. The wipers are operated.

The winter park position can be disabled or enabled via the touchscreen as follows:

1. Touch the **settings** icon.¹
2. Select **Vehicle**.
3. Select **Convenience**.
4. Select **Wipers**.
5. Touch the **Winter Wiper Park** toggle to disable or enable the feature.
6. Touch the **exit** icon.²
