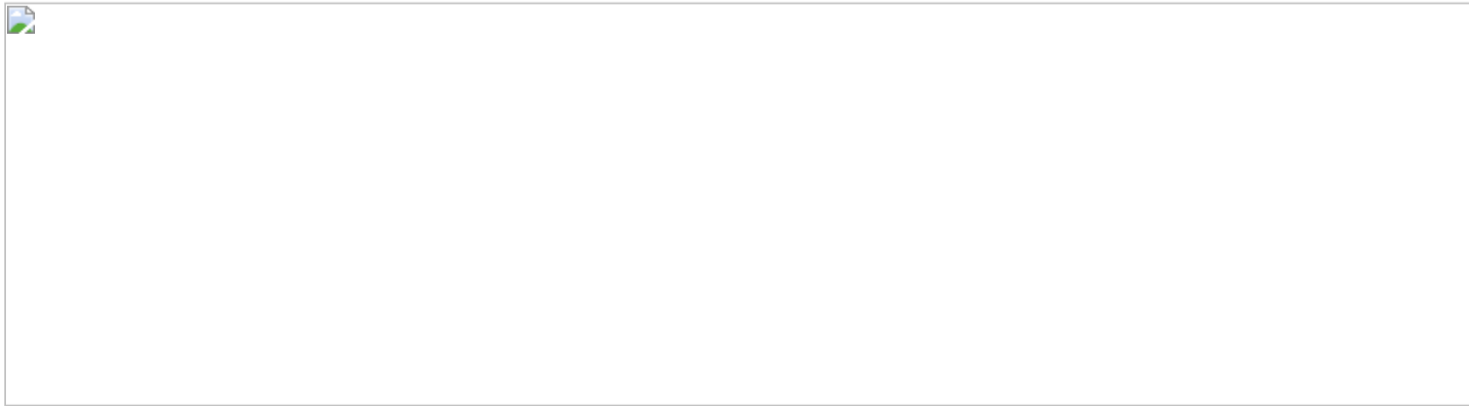
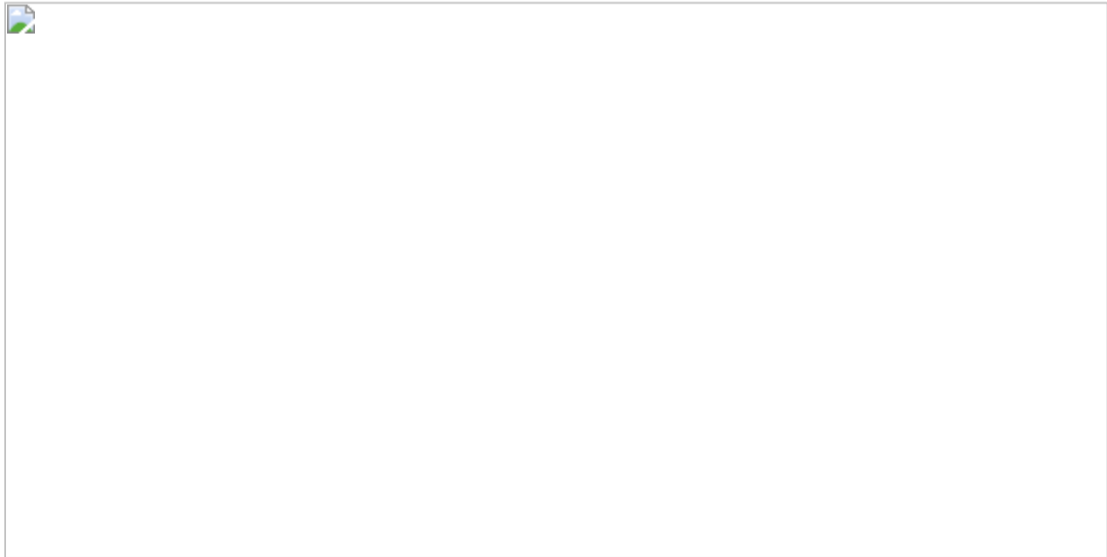

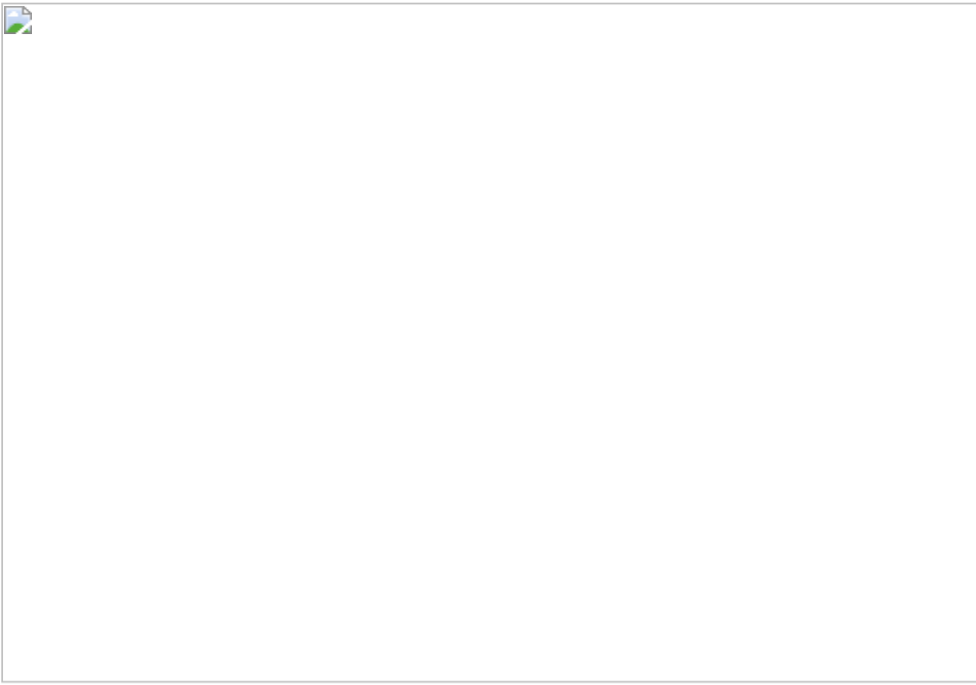

Condition	<p>Customers may comment their A/C system is inoperative or blows warm air.</p> <p>Technicians may find signs of oil/dirt located at the receiver/dryer cap.</p>
Cause	Some oil in this area should be considered normal due to assembly process. See examples below.

Pictures below are examples of conditions that should be considered normal.



Technician should use the GE 50078 Electronic Leak Detector or GE 42220/J 42220 Universal 12V Leak Detection Lamp to confirm a leak in this area as shown in picture below.



Note: Only replace the component if evidence of a leak is found. Do NOT replace any components based on the evidence of dirt collection.
