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Subject: Updated Procedure for Request and Release of Bendix® Electronic Control Unit (ECU) Data Downloads

This bulletin provides an update to the procedure outlined in *BW8206, Request and Release of Bendix® Electronic Control Unit (ECU) Data Download*. With the March 2024 Bendix divestment of the SafetyDirect® product line to Rand McNally®, the companies are splitting the data download request and release process.

NOTE: Effective January 1, 2025, all SafetyDirect and AutoVue® products should be sent to Rand McNally for data extraction. Remaining Bendix products should be sent to Bendix for processing. Further instruction will be provided closer to January 1, 2025. See below for product details.

Bendix ECUs will continue to be sent to Bendix with an updated release form and payment for processing. After January 1, 2025, the Rand McNally SafetyDirect ECUs will be sent to a new shipping address along with the new Rand McNally release form and payment to process the SafetyDirect ECUs.

As the new procedure implementation date nears, further information and the required updated forms will be provided. Until further notice, please continue to send all ECUs to Bendix at the Avon location.
