Workshop findings:

- The concern can be reproduced.
- No DTCs are stored in the front camera -R242- or in the distance regulation control module, J428 (address word 0013) and distance regulation control module 2, J850 (address word 008B).

Technical Background 1

Audi pre sense processes the wheel speed signal provided by the ABS control module, J104 (address word 0003). All four wheel-speeds are monitored and compared simultaneously.

Different wheel sizes on the vehicle, differences in tread depth, or unapproved wheel/tire combinations can lead to the message "Audi pre sense currently restricted. See owner's manual".
