

## **SITUATION**




BMW AG has issued a Delivery Stop (effective November 4, 2024) on a small number of Model Year 2025 BMW vehicles that were produced on October 14, 2024.

Vehicles produced on October 14, 2024, with option code(s) 05AS (Active Driving Assistant) and/or 5AU (Driving Assistance Pro); and have a short-range radar sensor (SRR sensor) clipped into the left and right rear of the vehicle. The short-range radar sensor (SRR sensor) on the right rear of the vehicle may come loose while driving.

A loose short-range sensor (SRR sensor) may cause a fault in the driver assistance system which is displayed to the customer via a check control message (CCM). In individual cases, the performance of this driver assistance function maybe reduced/not functioning if the vehicle is being approached from the right rear.

Replace the right rear bumper bracket following the repair instructions listed in ISTA/AIR 51 12 160.
