SERVICE ACTION: INSTALLATION OF INCORRECT ROOF ANTENNA

AFFECTED VEHICLES

- Vehicles which require this campaign to be completed will show it as "Open" when checked either in AIR, AWP, Campaign Summary, or Warranty Vehicle Inquiry
- Please make sure you check your center's inventory as soon as possible. You can see a list of affected vehicles in Inventory Campaign Details (ICD) under ROSS
- For centers that qualify, this Service Action repair is eligible to be performed via Mobile Assistance

SITUATION

Customer may complain that the hands-free option with SA 5AX – "Highway Assistant" can no longer be activated.

CAUSE

Due to a previous mistake in the Electronic Parts Catalog, the incorrect antenna (aka aerial) may have been ordered and installed in the vehicle.

CORRECTION

Replace the roof antenna with the correct part number.

PROCEDURE

Remove and replace the roof antenna with the correct part number as per the repair instructions:

REP 65 20 020 – "Removing and installing/replacing roof antenna (For equipment specification without sliding/tilting sunroof)".

PARTS INFORMATION

Use and invoice the following part numbers.

Additionally, other materials and small parts that are not specified above, such as fluids, lubricants, one-time use screws, nuts, and seals, which must be replaced or installed (according to the ISTA repair instructions/ETK/AIR), are to be selected from the Electronic Parts Catalog(aka aerial), and/or other approved BMW Group resources according to the respective vehicle type. Invoiced these items separately under the Repair Code listed in this bulletin.

CLAIM INFORMATION

Reimbursement for this Service Action will be via normal claim entry utilizing the applicable work package information below and the part numbers listed above.

Claim Repair Comments

Only reference the SIB number and the work package (Pkg) number performed in the technician's RO notes and in the claim comments (For example: B65 33 24 WP 1), unless otherwise required by State law.

Alternative Mobility Solution (AMS) for Vehicle Owners (RO and Claim Comments Required)

This Service Action repair qualifies for Alternative Mobility Solution (AMS) expense reimbursement, claim this item under the Defect Code noted above as follows:
