<b>Condition</b>	<p><b>Some customers may comment that they are experiencing premature front brake pad wear.</b></p> <p><b>Typically, the brake pads may only last a few thousand miles after replacement.</b></p>
<b>Cause</b>	<p><b>The cause of this concern could be a change to the brake pad lining material starting mid year 2022.</b></p> <p><b>This change was made to help with brake pad noise but has been found to prematurely wear out under certain driving condition where the brakes can get very hot, like during mountainous driving or heavy city/stop and go traffic.</b></p> <p><b>NOTE: Vehicles built after mid 2022 model year and the GM replacement brake pads for all model years (2019-2024) are made of the new brake pad lining material, which may have premature brake lining life if driving in condition that get the brakes very hot.</b></p>

#### Correction:

If after inspecting the brake system and no other faults are found causing premature brake pad wear, then replace the front brake pads with part number 84847749 which will provide improved pad life.
