**NOTE:** Prior to getting the session log of the vehicle wide DTC's Please do NOT clear any DTC'S This data is needed to ensure accurate diagnostics.

During Transmission Diagnostics it may become necessary to start a Technical Assistance Case.

In order to provide the best diagnostic experience additional information is now required.

Prior to starting a Technical Assistance Case please perform a vehicle wide DTC scan and upload the session and the picture to the case using Dealer Case Management,

For Canadian Dealers after obtaining the session log please email them following the process in [PIP4902R](#).

This information will be critical in providing a timely response without the need to request additional information.

Also, if a case is started for a leak concern Pictures of the leak test with the leak trace powder applied must be attached to the case.

Pictures of the leak test with the leak test powder should also be included in the warranty claim as well.

**NOTE:** Failure to include the pictures with the warranty claim WILL result in a debit of the entire repair to the dealer.
