Eligible Vehicles

To assist you in identifying those vehicles that have this component-specific extended limited warranty (ELW) coverage ELW, the following Vehicle Comment will show in the VIN-specific Warranty Vehicle Inquiry (WVI).

SI B65 01 22 (RC 61 12 90 03 00): For this vehicle, the limited warranty for the Knee Air Bag wire harness repair cable procedure for defects in materials and / or workmanship has been extended to 10 years / 120,000 miles as determined from the original first in-service / delivery date. This coverage is subject to the same vehicle eligibility requirements, limitations, and exclusion criteria that apply to the BMW New Vehicle Limited Warranty (January 2025).

Note: Before performing a repair and submitting a claim, first confirm that the above Notice shows, confirming that it applies to the vehicle.

If you have eligibility and/or coverage questions, please contact the Warranty department through IDS by selecting Coverage, Policy, Coding Questions and Mileage Corrections prior to performing any repair.

SITUATION

A check control message (CCM) for the restraint system (Air bag) appears. In the instrument cluster, the red air bag warning light lights up permanently.

One of the following fault codes is stored in the ACSM (air bag control unit):

930949 - Knee airbag, driver: short circuit to negative terminal

93094F - Knee airbag, front passenger: short circuit to negative terminal

93094C - Knee airbag driver's side: Resistance too great **930952** - Knee airbag, front passenger: Resistance too great

Component, Issue, and Repair-Specific Extended Limited Warranty (ELW) Coverage

For the eligible vehicles that qualify, BMW of North America, LLC (BMW NA) is extending the limited warranty coverage for these vehicles' when it is required to be performed, the:

- Knee Air Bag wire harness repair cable procedure to:
- 10 years/120,000 miles, as determined by the vehicle's original first in-service/ delivery date.

This component, issue, repair specific extended limited warranty coverage applies to defects in materials or workmanship.

This coverage applies to the specific vehicle (VIN), the remaining portion of the ELW is transferrable to each subsequent owner, and it is subject to the same vehicle eligibility requirements, limitations, and exclusion criteria that applies to the BMW New Vehicle Limited Warranty for Passenger Cars and Light Trucks.

Air bag replacement(s) and/or the repair of other SRS-related issues are excluded under this coverage.

Note: This bulletin is notice of a limited warranty extension. This is NOT a notice of a Recall or Service Action.

There is no immediate repair required unless the BMW vehicle is currently experiencing this problem.

Customer Notification Letter

Even though this is NOT a Recall, BMW NA is sending VIN-specific customer notification letters.

CAUSE

Over time, the wiring harness going to the knee air bag(s) can rub against the metal support tubes for the instrument panel, chafing and damaging the wiring.

CORRECTION

Remove the center console to access the ACSM control module.

Remove the under-dash trim panels on both the driver's and passenger's sides.

This gives sufficient access to perform this repair.

The dashboard cover does not need to be removed.

The knee air bags do not need to be removed.

The knee air bag harnesses end connectors are cut off and the wiring taped back to the harness.

Run the new air bag repair wiring harnesses from the ACSM control module to both knee air bags.


The replacement harnesses do not need to follow the same exact routing path as the original.

Both replacement harnesses are to be installed, even if there is only a fault showing for one side.

PROCEDURE

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2- Remove the **center console** as per **Repair Instructions 51 16 165** to access the Air Bag Control Module **A11 (ACSM)** wiring connector (**A11*2B**).


Check the ACSM module for signs of corrosion within the electrical connectors.

3-Follow **Repair Instructions 51 45 184** (Plus code 51 45 684 included in 51 16 665) to remove the underdash trim panel on the driver's side.

- Unplug the connector (B8*1B) on the knee air bag on the driver's side.
- Cut the knee air bag wiring harness near the connector and tie back the cut wiring with a cable strap

4- Follow **Repair Instructions 51 45 195** (Plus code 51 45 695 included in 51 16 665) to remove the underdash trim panel on the passenger side.

- Unplug the connector (B77*1B) on the knee air bag on the passenger's side.
- Cut the knee air bag wiring harness near the connector and tie back the cut wiring with a cable strap
- The repair wiring will be run together with the additional harness protection addressed in the next steps



5- Apply felt tape to the locations pictured.

6- The knee air bag wiring should be protected from chafing at the dash support bracket.


Glue the felt generously onto the support tube or to the corresponding edge.

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Important: The felt must be glued around the edge!



7- The replacement harness does not need to follow the same exact path as the original.

Install felt tape in any other potential chafe location.

8- Unplug the wiring connector from the ACSM (A11*2B).

Reference Wiring Diagram 'Airbag firing circuits' SP0000061332 and confirm the wire color and pin number BEFORE cutting these 4 wires at the ACSM connector.

9- Cut the 4 wires for the knee air bag wiring harnesses near the ACSM connector and tie back the 4 cut wires with a cable strap.

- ACSM Pin 25 (A11*2B) goes to pin 1 of driver knee air bag (B8*1B).
- ACSM Pin 20 (A11*2B) goes to pin 2 of driver knee air bag (B8*1B).
- ACSM Pin 5 (A11*2B) goes to pin 1 of passenger knee air bag (B77*1B).
- ACSM Pin 10 (A11*2B) goes to pin 2 of passenger knee air bag (B77*1B).

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Then pin 2 repair cables into the airbag control unit connector (A11*2B).

Wrap the knee wiring harnesses with an abrasion-resistant fabric tape (part number 61 13 6 925 452).

Route one repair harness to the knee airbag on the driver's side and the other to the knee air bag on the passenger's side. The replacement harness does not need to follow the same exact path as the original.

PARTS INFORMATION

Only order these parts in the quantities needed to address customers' vehicles that have confirmed failures.

To determine the part numbers that applies to the specific vehicle being repaired, enter the VIN/chassis number into either ETK or AIR, this will consider the specific equipment and/or options that are fitted to the vehicle.

Additionally, other materials and small parts that are not specified above, such as fluids, lubricants, one-time use screws, nuts, and seals, which must be replaced or installed according to the ISTA repair instructions/ETK, must be selected from the Electronic Parts Catalogue, or other approved BMW Group resources, according to the respective vehicle type. Invoiced these items separately under the Repair Code listed in this bulletin.

CLAIM INFORMATION

For eligible US-specification BMW vehicles that are registered and operated in the United States (including Puerto Rico), the component and issue specific 10 years (120 months) / 120,000-mile extended limited warranty coverage for defects in materials and/or workmanship applies to qualifying repairs, as described above, that are performed by authorized BMW centers.

This component, issue, repair specific extended limited warranty coverage applies to defects in materials or workmanship.

This coverage applies to the specific vehicle (VIN), the remaining portion of the ELW is transferrable to each subsequent owner, and it is subject to the same vehicle eligibility requirements, limitations, and exclusion criteria that applies to the BMW New Vehicle Limited Warranty for Passenger Cars and Light Trucks.

Air bag replacement(s) and/or the repair of other SRS-related issues are excluded under this coverage.

The existing limited warranty coverage for the whole vehicle and other components has not changed.

This coverage supersedes the coverage that is provided under the BMW Certified Pre-Owned Program or any BMW Group Vehicle Service Contract that applies to the vehicle.

For the issue described in this bulletin, the "Repair cable, airbag system" is then covered by the remaining portion of the extended limited warranty coverage period.

Non-Qualifying Repairs

Repairs performed on ineligible vehicles, eligible vehicles operated and repaired outside the United States and Puerto Rico, or the diagnosis and repair of issues that are outside the intended scope of this extended coverage, engine damage is not covered, other unrelated issues, and/or that are due to outside influences are not covered by this limited warranty extension. This exclusion also applies to repairs that were performed using

Previous Customer-Pay Repairs – Extended Limited Warranty Reimbursement

BMW of North America, LLC (BMW NA) will provide reimbursement for qualifying customer-pay repairs that were performed on an eligible vehicle **prior** to the release of this component, issue, and repair specific extended limited warranty.

A qualifying customer pay repair must primarily be for a covered issue that required the repair of the vehicle's knee airbag wire harnesses. Also, the repair facility 's procedures to address the above situation must have been performed correctly, adequately, and completely, as required by the applicable BMW Group approved repair standards and instructions.

Air bag replacement(s) and/or the repair of other SRS-related issues are excluded under this coverage.

Customer-pay repairs are subject to the same vehicle eligibility requirements, limitations, and exclusion criteria that applies to the BMW New Vehicle Limited Warranty for Passenger Cars and Light Trucks.

Effective as of the date above, the following Important Vehicle Limited Warranty Information, applies to the BMW model with Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) 5UXTY5C02L1234567.

Dear BMW Owner/Lessee:

For the above reference vehicle, BMW of North America, LLC ("BMW NA") is extending the limited warranty for the Supplemental Restraint System's (SRS):

- Left and right knee air bag wiring harnesses, which connect to the SRS (ACSM) control module, to:
- 10 years/120,000 miles, whichever occurs first, as determined from your vehicle's original in-service/first delivery date.

The knee air bags' wire harness routing near the instrument panel's metal support tubes may not be adequate to avoid contact. Over time, chafing of the harnesses insulating material could occur in the areas where they contact the metal support tubes, eventually, the wiring itself can also then become damaged. Should this happen, the corresponding Check Control Messages (CCM) will display, the vehicle's monitoring system may also generate and store the corresponding fault codes, and the SRS warning light will illuminate.

This component issue and repair-specific extended limited warranty (ELW) applies to defects in materials and/or workmanship. This coverage is subject to the same vehicle eligibility requirements and limitations that apply to the BMW New Vehicle Limited Warranty for Passenger Cars and Light Trucks.

Note: This is a notice of a special component issue and repair-specific coverage program. This is NOT a notice of a Recall or Service Action.

If your vehicle is experiencing a situation like the one described above, please contact your authorized BMW center to schedule an appointment to have the issue with your vehicle diagnosed.

After the BMW center confirms that the scope of this component issue and repair-specific extended limited warranty coverage corresponds and applies to the required vehicle repair, and your vehicle qualifies, the authorized BMW center will perform the covered knee air bag wire harness repair work free of charge. Air bag replacement(s) and/or the repair of other SRS-related issues are excluded under this coverage.
