Condition

Customer states:

When turning in, when the suspension compresses/extends, driving over bumps, speed humps, creaking noises can be heard in the front.

Workshop findings:

Anti-roll bar rests against subframe of front axle (Figures 1 and 2).

Technical Background 1

Subframe dimensional accuracy is not OK.

Production Solution

Expansion of the measuring points during production of the subframe.

Service

- If the anti-roll bar rests on the subframe, replace it and the anti-roll bar.
