INTRODUCTION

Nissan is conducting this voluntary emissions recall campaign on certain specific model year 2016-2019 Titan XD vehicles with Diesel engines to inspect and, if necessary, replace the Vehicle Emission Control Information Label. This service will be performed at no charge to the customer for parts or labor.

IDENTIFICATION NUMBER

Nissan has assigned identification number PD127 to this campaign. This number must appear on all communication and documentation of any nature dealing with this campaign.

DEALER RESPONSIBILITY

It is the dealer's responsibility to check Service COMM or Dealer Business Systems (DBS) National Service History for the campaign status on each vehicle falling within the range of this voluntary emissions recall which for any reason enters the service department. This includes vehicles purchased from private parties or presented by transient (tourist) owners and vehicles in a dealer's inventory. **Federal law requires that new vehicles in dealer inventory which are the subject of a safety recall must be corrected prior to sale. Failure to do so can result in civil penalties by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.** While federal law applies only to new vehicles, Nissan strongly encourages dealers to correct any used vehicles in their inventory before they are retailed.

Bulletins are intended for use by qualified technicians, not 'do-it-yourselfers'. Qualified technicians are properly trained individuals who have the equipment, tools, safety instruction, and know-how to do a job properly and safely. **NOTE:** If you believe that a described condition may apply to a particular vehicle, DO NOT assume that it does. See your Nissan dealer to determine if this applies to your vehicle.

IMPORTANT

Attention California Dealers (Retailers)

An Emission Recall Campaign Completion (ERCC) label must be filled out by the technician performing the repair, and then attached to the underside of the vehicle hood. A sample of the label is shown below.

California law prohibits owners from renewing their California registration if emissions related recall work has not been performed. California dealers are now required to issue a proof of correction certificate to vehicle owners upon completion of emissions related recall work. Please fill out one of the campaign completion forms for each owner that has this campaign performed. Instruct owners to keep this certificate unless they are requested to mail it to the DMV. A sample of the form is shown in Figure 2 below.

HINT:

- When either item (form or label) is ordered, you will automatically receive the other item as well.

SERVICE PROCEDURE

1. Open the hood and inspect for the presence of the Cummins Emission Exemption Label shown in Figure 3.

HINT: The Cummins Emission Exemption Label can be located anywhere within the area shown in Figure 3.

- Is the Cummins Emission Exemption Label shown in Figure 3 present?

YES: Remove the Cummins Emissions Exemption Label, clean any residual adhesive from the hood, and then proceed to step 2 on page 4.

NO: Proceed to step 2 on page 4.

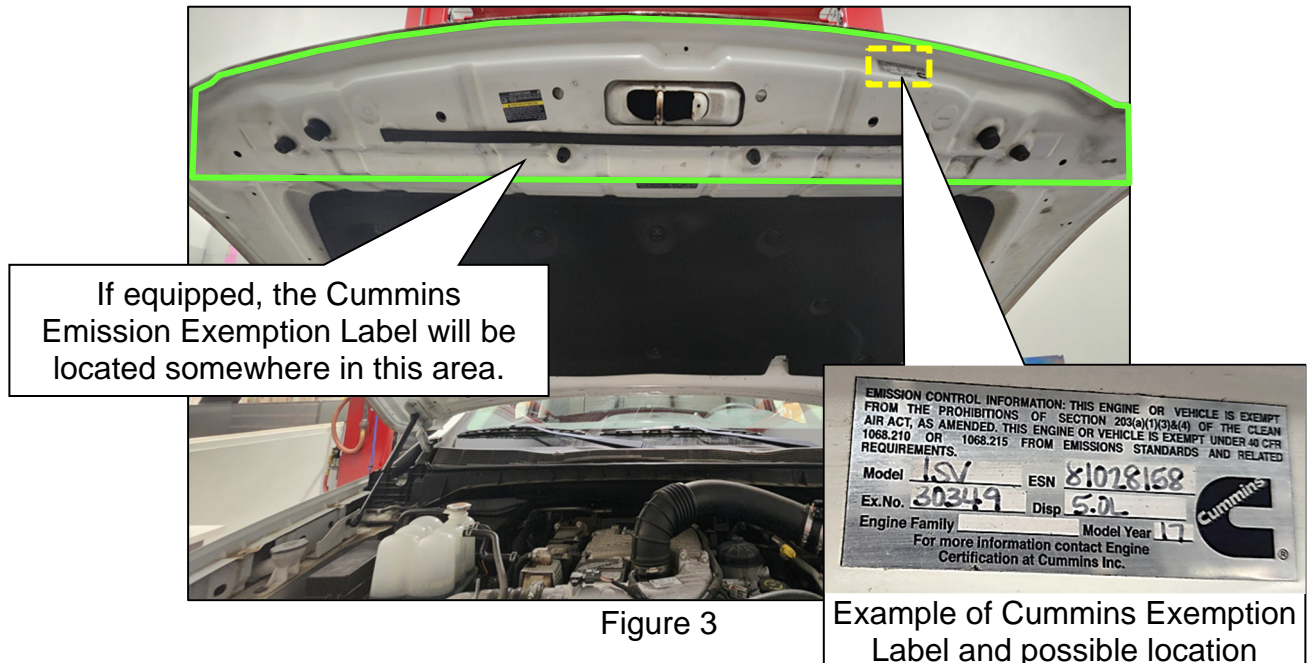

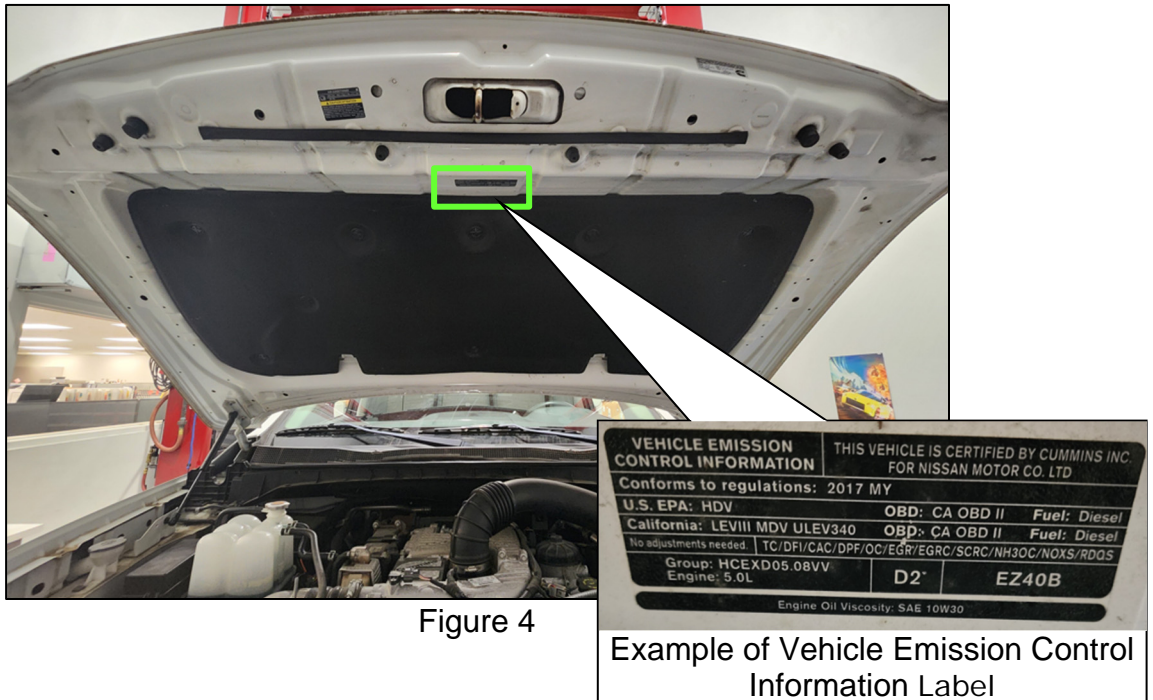
Example of Cummins Exemption Label and possible location

2. Inspect for the presence of the Vehicle Emission Control Information Label shown in Figure 4.

- Is the Vehicle Emission Control Information Label shown in Figure 4 present?

YES: The Vehicle Emission Control Information Label is already installed and no further action is necessary. Close the hood and see the **CLAIMS INFORMATION** on page 5.

NO: The Vehicle Emission Control Information Label is NOT installed. Continue to step 3 to install a new label.



3. Install a Vehicle Emission Control Information Label where shown in Figure 4.

- a. Using a suitable cleaner and shop towel, first clean the area shown in Figure 4.
- b. Carefully install the new Vehicle Emission Control Information Label.
